

### SIMV launches its new call for proposals for animal health innovations for 2024



The French Veterinary Medicines and Diagnostics Industry federation (SIMV) is launching **its new** call for innovations in animal health for 2024.

# Animal health research meetings

The 10<sup>th</sup> Animal Health Research Meetings will be held from 3 to 4 December 2024 in Lille.

These meetings, which aim to promote partnership research in the animal health sector, will take place in several forms:

- Pre-qualified business meetings (confidential face-to-face) between project coordinators and SIMV members as well as with other BioFIT participants
- Public **oral presentation sessions** (*pitches*) of the most innovative projects in animal health (projects selected by a jury)
- > A conference session on animal health

Last year, <u>15 innovative projects were selected to compete</u>. The partnership between the SIMV and the SATT network had increased the number and quality of files received.

#### In what context?

Our meetings are held within the framework of the international business convention <u>BioFIT</u>, dedicated to technology transfer, academia-industry collaborations, and innovation and early-stage investment in the field of Life Sciences to facilitate the transfer of innovation between the 2 human and veterinary medicines.



In 2024, <u>BioFIT</u> will be organised jointly with <u>MedFIT</u>, dedicated to innovation partnerships and investment cycles in the MedTech and Diagnostics sectors, as well as with <u>MEDigIT</u>, the new European convention for innovation in digital health.

#### What projects are expected?

The projects expected are very broad-based innovations in relation to **welfare** and **animal health** (diagnosis, prevention, vaccine, therapeutic, medical device, connected health, etc.).

They may be at different maturity levels (upstream, downstream or applied): no project is excluded at this stage.**e-health** projects in the field of veterinary medicine are also welcome.

### **Project format**

All project sheets must be written **in English**, and must only contain **non-confidential data**. There must be as many completed forms as there must be a project.

The information expected is that which makes it possible to best define the stage of development of the project.

### **Evaluation and valuation of projects**

Projects will be evaluated by the SIMV expert members according to three main criteria:

- maturity,
- suitability for the veterinary market,
- > technicality and innovation.

Following this evaluation, all projects will be mapped according to these different criteria and shared more widely with all SIMV members for the organisation of meetings during the meetings.
